

Rejuvenating Roseburn - Community Engagement



The Council is proposing significant changes to the street layout on Murrayfield Avenue, Murrayfield Place and the Old Coltbridge, to improve the environment for people in these spaces (See designs overleaf). This will include:

- Significantly wider pavements and additional 'Public Realm' (pedestrian space)
- Safer, easier and more direct road crossings
- Improved pavement surfaces

The Council is working in partnership with Murrayfield Community Council to understand the needs and wants of the local community, so that we can work together to develop outstanding designs for this public space in line with the Roseburn Action Plan. This could include:

- More greenery, planting and street trees
- Places to sit and relax
- Public artworks and sculpture
