



The City Centre West to East Link project

Road and cycleway line marking

We wanted to update you on our plans to carry out road and cycleway line marking between Roseburn and Wester Coates. The work will take place between 10 and 14 July and must be carried out on nightshift to reduce traffic disruption. This is because of it being next to the A8 corridor and busy Roseburn junction.

This letter has been distributed to you as you are within 100m of one of our work locations. The weather and parked cars may dictate where we are each night. As the duration at each individual work location will be short, we will work in multiple locations throughout each night.

Some of the line marking work is noisy as it involves the use of a heat lance to burn off existing line markings. We will ensure any noisy work is carried out before 11pm and quieter activities are done during the later part of the shift. We will make every effort to reduce disruption whilst this essential road safety work is completed.

Safety is our priority

During construction, pedestrian and traffic management measures will be installed and maintained to make sure the works can be carried out safely for everyone, including residents, business and our workforce.
