

City centre west to east cycle link and street Improvements

Traffic Regulation and Redetermination Orders Consultation



The Council is committed to making it safer and easier for people to get around the city by bike.

We are making a new cycle route through the city centre from Roseburn in the west to Leith Walk in the east. We are also improving things for pedestrians.

We carried out a public consultation on plans for this route in 2015-16 and have been working with key stakeholders including Community Councils and interest groups such as Spokes and Living Streets since then to progress the designs.

Traffic Regulation Order (TRO)

Before the Council can make

changes to parking and loading restrictions we must provide an opportunity for people to comment. This is a Traffic Regulation Order.

Redetermination Order (RSO)

We also must provide an opportunity for people to comment before we can change the layout of pavements, roads and cycle paths. This a Redetermination Order.

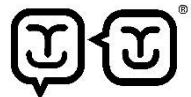
