At the Murrayfield Community Council meetings held on November 5<sup>th</sup> 2019 and June 29<sup>th</sup> 2021, the subject of overhanging and overgrown trees, bushes and hedges in the area was raised by many people. This is affecting pedestrians walking on the pavement, it is creating a health and safety issue, and may also be affecting neighbours. We kindly request you to cut back your overhanging/over grown vegetation which is intruding on the land outside of your boundary.
